Getting to the Elder Museum of Science and Technology

The Elder Museum is located in the heart of the city at Parque Santa Catalina, making it highly accessible for attendees via foot, bike, or public transport.

- **Local Buses (Guaguas Municipales):** Almost all major lines stop at the Santa Catalina Interchange or nearby. Key lines include 1, 2, 12, 21, 24, 33, and 47.
- **Regional Buses (Global):** If you are traveling from outside the city (such as the south of the island or the airport), lines 01, 30, 60, and 91 will take you directly to the underground Santa Catalina station, just steps from the museum.
- **Sitycleta:** For a more sustainable arrival, there are several smart bike stations located immediately adjacent to the museum and the surrounding park.
- **Parking:** For those driving, the Sanapú and Elder underground parking lots provide direct access to the venue.

How to get to Las Palmas de Gran Canaria:

By Plane

Las Palmas de Gran Canaria is served by Gran Canaria Airport (LPA), one of the busiest in Spain, offering numerous domestic and international flights. The airport is located approximately 18 kilometres south of the city centre.

By Coach

The most convenient public transport option from the airport to the city is by coach, Lines 60 and 91, operated by Global for 2.95€ per ticket.

- **Stops:**
 - San Telmo Bus Station: Located near the Vegueta-Triana district.
 - Santa Catalina Bus Station: Close to Elder Museum, Las Canteras area and major hotels.
- Coaches run frequently throughout the day, making it an affordable and reliable option.

By Car or Taxi from the Airport

- **Taxi:** Readily available at the arrivals terminal; the fare to the city centre or Santa Catalina is roughly €30–€35.
- **Car Rental:** Major agencies are located within the airport, offering a flexible way to reach the city and explore the island.
